The Town Green Dump is open by appointment only.; you must call Town Hall at 970.353.1681 and coordinate a time with Town Staff to provide access to the dump. Signs have been installed allowing for specific locations to dump different types of materials and listing what is not accepted. Grass clippings are welcome, however, be sure to dump them in the appropriate space; DO NOT leave trash bags at the dump site. For more information, please contact Town Hall.
