| PAPER | Newspaper and its inserts. Office paper, junk mail, envelopes, magazines, catalogues, books and phone books. | Place in bin. Set bin at curb when full on collection day. | |
| METALS | Aluminum cans, tin cans, pie/food trays, clean aluminum foil, scrap metal (broken rake, toaster, clean paint cans etc.) copper and brass items. | Rinse/wash. Place in bin. Set bin at curb when full on collection day. | No dirty pie/food trays, or foil, wet paint cans. |
| PLASTICS | All plastic containing the recycling symbol. | Rinse/wash. Remove caps. Place in bin. Set bin at curb when full on collection day. | No plastic bags, pesticide or weed killer containers, styrofoam, plastic wraps, plastic tubs, toys, lids and caps. |
| GLASS | Food and beverage jars and bottles. | Rinse/wash. Remove all lids. Place in bin. Set bin at curb when full on collection day. | No household window, window panes, auto glass, or light bulbs of any kind accepted. |
| CARDBOARD | Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, paper towel & toilet paper rolls, CLEAN pizza boxes, gift boxes, corrugated cardboard, and paperboard. | Remove inner liner/bags and food particles. | No inner bags or dirty/greasy pizza boxes. |
