### Greetings...

As the upcoming election draws closer, I want to encourage anyone with an interest in helping our town pick up a petition for board vacancies. This year we have three Trustee openings, as well as the position of Town Mayor. Pick up your petition, get signatures and return it to Town Hall by January 22nd. I promise you don't want to miss this rewarding experience!

Just a reminder for when snow comes, we do have an updated snow removal route plan. You can find this on our website or at Town Hall. If your vehicles are left parked within snow route boundaries it will be towed at your expense. Please pay attention to snow route maps and signs to alleviate any issues.

I will say, 2017 was a great year for Kersey...with the annexation of the Platte River Fort, County Road 49 and the addition of the Solar Farm, we have brought many benefits to the Town and community members! In future years Town Hall will be moved to the building at the corner of First Avenue and Trumbull St.; we have purchased that facility and plan to create a beautiful town center building.

The Town is also in the process of pursuing another facility to house the Kersey Community Center and Kersey Seniors Corporation. We were also the first community on the Front Range to host Pedal the Plains. The population of Kersey practically doubled that weekend; and with the presence of the Governor, we gained some very positive

exposure for a small community. We ended the year on a high note with a great turnout at the Parade of Lights event; I want to thank the many people who helped decorate throughout town to celebrate the Christmas festivities as well. Our Town Public Works Department did a tremendous job decorating; the park and town looked extremely beautiful this season!

### 2018 Dog License and Tags:

Available December 1st with proof of 'rabies vaccination'. \$10 for altered and \$20 for non-altered dogs. All dogs within Kersey Town limits must be licensed.

### Planning and Zoning Vacancies:

Meetings first Tuesday of each month. Must have 12 month current consecutive residence within Kersey Town limits to be selected. We have one vacancy left to fill!
